### Shelter Area

### featuring an Open Lawn, Natural Playground, Fitness Zones and Multi-Use Trails



The Shelter Area featuring the Open Lawn, Natural Playground and Fitness Zone will include multiple giving opportunities ranging from \$75,000 to \$150.

Our Open Lawn will allow families to enjoy a relaxing picnic near a water feature or in the shadow of a whimsical, whirling sculpture.

The Natural Playground will allow kids of all ages and abilities to explore nature in a familiar way. Large boulders, a grassy hill slide and zip line will be featured.

For those looking to test their abilities or simply begin an exercise routine, the Fitness Zone will meet that need. Featured in the Zone are challenging obstacle course elements for adults that mimic the popular "Spartan" races. A state of the art youth challenge course designed to mimic the NFL combine and America Ninja Warrior will challenge youth of all ages. On the perimeter of the fitness zone will be several pieces of traditional outdoor exercise equipment to work all major muscle groups and cardio.

Encircling the entire area will be a 18' dual surface, multi-use trail; 16' wide, paved track with a 2' wide shoulder of granite screenings.

#### Soccer/Lacrosse Complex

## featuring a Championship Field, five Regulation Fields, Full Field Lighting, a Scoring/Concession Tower and Playground



The Soccer/Lacrosse Complex will feature five full size, natural grass fields with the flexibility to host up to 10 games at one time for the youngest age groups. It will also include a Championship Complex able to host more spectators. The complex will allow the Department to expand it's popular soccer program which is currently only limited by field space. The growing Lacrosse program will also benefit from the new facility.

In addition to the local recreation teams, the complex will host regional and statewide tournaments, attracting citizens from around our state to Graham, thus boosting our local economy.

Giving opportunities at this complex range from \$100 to \$1,250,000. Naming rights at this complex include the entire complex, individual fields and the concession/scoring tower.

#### **Baseball/Softball Complex**

#### featuring four 300' Fields, Full Field Lighting, Bullpens, Batting Cages, a Scoring/Concession Tower and Playground



The Baseball/Softball Complex will feature four 300', natural grass fields with the ability to add temporary fencing to reduce the field dimension to 200'. This flexibility will allow the facility to host recreation baseball and softball games as well as regional and statewide tournaments.

The complex will also feature a concession stand/scoring tower that will house restrooms, a conference room for tournament directors and dressing rooms for game officials. A bullpen and batting cage will be built adjacent to each field to provide additional practice and warm-up options.

Giving opportunities at this complex range from \$150 to \$1,250,000. Naming rights at this complex include the entire complex, individual fields and the concession/scoring tower.


