### **COVID-19 Facility Protocols and Best Practices**

**Effective 11.27.2020**

Graham Recreation & Parks welcomes you to Downtown Graham's Ice Skating Rink. Our primary concern is the health and safety of our participants, staff, and their families. To make the ice rink possible for the community this year, we are taking measures to protect everyone attending.

Please see the COVID-19 Facility Protocols and Best Practices to facilitate social distancing and ensure the facilities remain clean and safe:

1. Our facility adheres to Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), NC Department of Health and Human Services (NCDHHS), and Alamance County Health Department guidelines and mandates;
2. Dedicated staff throughout the sessions continuously disinfect the ice rink fencing, benches, skate helpers, and skates with disinfectant wipes and an Electrostatic Fogger containing virus-killing Disinfectant Solution ([Boardwalk Disinfecting Wipes](#) and [NEUQUAT Neutral Disinfect/Cleaner](#));
3. A hand sanitizing station is located at the Skate Hut;
4. Lower capacity on the rink has been implemented to allow for social distancing for participants;
5. All staff are to wear masks/face coverings (as mandated) and are required to sanitize and/or wash hands regularly throughout their shifts;
6. Everyone on and off the rink over the age of two (2) years old are required to wear a mask/face covering pursuant to the Executive Order Phase Guidelines. The mask/face covering is required at all times when at the ice rink no matter if on or off the ice rink.;
7. Participants and staff are required to stay home if exhibiting a fever, cold and/or flu-like symptoms;
8. All staff are subject to health checks prior to starting work each day (as of 12.14.2020).

As the COVID-19 situation is constantly changing and guidelines may change, these protocols and best practices are subject to change by Graham Recreation & Parks at any time at the sole discretion of supervisors to maximize participant and staff safety.
