#### **Graham Appearance Commission Meeting**

**April 18, 2022**

- **Call Meeting to Order**
  - Meeting was called to order at 6:00 PM
  - Pledge of Allegiance
  - Moment of Silence
- **Approval of Minutes from April 4, 2021**
  - Clark-Baldwin makes the motion to approve, seconded by Hall. All in favor
- **Arbor Day Poster Contest**
  - Brandy McCandless presented the commission with the poster contest drawings
  - The commission selected Amelia Wells poster as the winner in the 3-5-year-old age group
  - The commission selected Stella Moss's poster as the winner in the 6-8-year-old group.
  - The commission selected Leah Edwards poster as the winner in the 9-11-year-old age group
  - The commission selected Neil Edwards poster as the winner in the 12-14-year-old age group
- **Text Amendment Presentation**
  - West presents the commission with the text amendment
  - Konzelmann notes she still has issues with the enclosed porch language
  - Clark-Baldwin requests Konzelmann presents what she would like to change
  - Konzelmann suggests the enclosed porch aspect be removed
  - Hall mentions the amendment had been reviewed multiple times and if any concerns were to arise with the language, legal staff and Council would adjust the text
  - Hall makes the motion to move forward with the current language to submit, seconded by Clark-Baldwin. 3-1 vote. Konzelmann not in favor
- **Spring Clean-up Discussion**
  - West presents a program with the New Leaf Foundation seeking to get municipalities out and participating in litter clean-up's during the spring time.
  - West notes the organization would provide all the necessary tools for the clean-up and could easily be acquired, but the date would need to be selected by the commission
  - Discussion over the location of the clean-up ensues and the commission suggests to
